The Order Sons of Italy in America (OSIA) is the largest organization of Americans of Italian descent in the United States and Canada. Our purpose is to unite all people of Italian descent to celebrate the culture and heritage of our ancestral country while celebrating the contributions of Italians to America.

Every year, the Grand Lodge of Colorado Foundation awards scholarships to deserving students from across the state. Each scholarship is awarded on the basis of leadership and academic achievement. These awards are in the amount of \$1,000 and are applied toward tuition at any accredited community college or university. These awards are open to graduating high school seniors as well as current undergraduate students. Undergraduate students must submit their final high school transcript along with a current college transcript. OSIA is dedicated to promoting excellence in education. Scholarship recipients will be awarded at the Grand Lodge of Colorado Golden Lion Luncheon at the Lakewood Country Club on Sunday, June 8, 2014. Recipients must be present to receive their award. Students unable to attend are not eligible for scholarship awards. **Applications will be accepted February 15, 2014 through April 30, 2014.** Applications postmarked after April 30, 2014 will not be considered.
